It is up to you to decide whether he is smart, weird, and/or stupid, but this presentation will stick to the real estate topic and lessons that can be learned for Germany.“

Prof. Dr. Tom Geurts teaches real estate at The George Washington University in Washington, DC (USA) and also teaches a yearly course at the TU-Berlin, which consists of one week in Berlin in November and one week in New York and Washington, DC in May. In these two weeks students learn about Real Estate Investment Analysis, Valuation, Finance, and Asset Management through theoretical analysis, case studies, and company visits.
